

# Proposed Garbage Fee Increase Notice:

On June 21, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. a Public Hearing will be held at the Board of Supervisor's Chambers at 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn, CA 95603 to consider increases in garbage collection fees in Franchise area 4 (Foresthill) of up to 4.0% (depending on the level of service) for FY 2011/12 (July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012) to reflect increases in the cost of living as measured by changes in the Employment Cost Index and Producer Price Index.

## Examples of Proposed Increases Include

- Monthly single can service fee is proposed to increase from \$16.74 to \$17.36 and monthly toter service is proposed to increase from \$29.08 to \$29.99.
- Monthly 4 yard commercial bin fee (weekly pick up) is proposed to increase from \$307.22 to \$317.68.
- Monthly parcel fee, which is mandatory to all developed parcels, is proposed to increase from \$17.40 to \$17.72.

All developed properties in Franchise Area 4 have full access to the Foresthill Transfer Station, Friday through Monday, with no fee for mixed solid waste, except for commercial customers. Also, all property owners in Franchise Area 4 may request and receive garbage collection service from Recology Auburn Placer. The basic parcel fee will be applied as a credit towards the cost of the service chosen.

The Board will consider written protests concerning the proposed increases in fees. Written protests must include the property owners name and address and can be mailed, presented at the Public Hearing, or personally delivered to:

If a majority of affected property owners file written protests, the proposed rate changes will not be imposed. State law provides that only the written protests of property owners may be considered to determine if a majority protest exists. No more than one protest per property may be submitted.
