



FEIST PARK TENNIS COURTS POLICIES

RESERVATIONS

Tennis courts are available for everyone and may be reserved for tournaments or special events. Please check the posted Parks Calendar or check the County website at http://www.placer.ca.gov/calciium4/calciium40.pl?CalendarName=Ron_Feist_Park_Tennis for court availability prior to use. **If the tennis courts are not reserved, they are available to the general public on a first come – first served basis.**

Per Agreement, the GRANITE BAY HIGH SCHOOL has first right of refusal for reserving the tennis courts for team practices, matches and for physical education classes. The Granite Bay High School may use all six courts at a time; however, if you arrive to play and find the high school team practicing, please feel free to ask the tennis coach if they can make a court available for your use. The high school has offered to do so any time they can. Should the tennis courts not be used by the high school during the stated reserved times, the courts are available to the public on a first come – first served basis.

- COURTS 1-4 MAY BE RESERVED.
- COURTS 5 & 6 ARE NOT TO BE RESERVED. They are to be kept open for drop in play by the general public.
- ALL COURTS may only be reserved for tennis matches, tournaments, or special events.

Fees Schedule:

- There is a \$5.00 fee for each reservation application and \$5 per change.
- No charge to Granite Bay High School for practices or events.
- \$2.00 per hour for general public use.
- \$15.00 per hour for schools.

MAINTENANCE

The tennis courts are maintained by volunteers and may be closed at any time for cleaning. Please wait until the courts are dry to begin playing. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

CHARGING FOR TENNIS LESSONS IS NOT PERMITTED. There shall be no charging of fees for tennis lessons given on Ronald L. Feist Park Tennis Courts.

INSURANCE is required for tournaments or special events or for reservations made by a school.
