Second Installment of Property Taxes Due

Placer County Treasurer-Tax Collector Jenine Windeshausen is reminding property owners that they have until Tuesday, April 10th, 2007 at 5 p.m. to make the second installment of their annual property taxes for the 2006-2007 year. This deadline should not be confused with the Federal and State income tax deadline. Pursuant to State law, late property tax payments are subject to an immediate 10% penalty and \$10.00 cost.

Payments sent by mail must be U. S. postmarked no later than April 10th. Payments made in person at the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office, 2976 Richardson Drive, Auburn, must be paid by 5 p.m. April 10th. For added convenience a drive-up deposit box in the front of the building as well as one in the lobby of the office are also available. Payments must be deposited in these drop boxes by 5 p.m. on April 10th. Anyone with a checking account may pay by virtual check over the Internet at www.placer.ca.gov/tax. To pay with MasterCard, Visa, Discover or American Express cards, taxpayers may call: 1-866-4TAXPMT (1-866-482-9768).

Taxpayers with questions about their bill may contact the Tax Collector's staff by calling, 530-889-4120, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Taxpayers may access tax information either by calling the same phone number and using the 24 hr. automated phone system, or by viewing it online at www.placer.ca.gov/tax. A parcel number is needed to obtain information through the automated phone system or online.
