First Installment of Property Taxes Due

Placer County Treasurer-Tax Collector Jenine Windeshausen is reminding property owners that they have until Monday, December 10th, 2007 at 5 p.m. to make the first installment of their annual property taxes for the 2007-2008 year.

To pay by credit card, debit card or e-check, visit www.placer.ca.gov/tax or call toll free: 1-866-4TAXPMT (1-866-593-9768), fees apply. To pay by virtual check, see our website at www.placer.ca.gov/tax. Mailed payments should be sent to P. O. Box 7790, Auburn, CA 95604-7790 and must be U.S. postmarked by December 10th, 2007 to avoid penalties. Payments may also be made in person at the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office at 2976 Richardson Drive in Auburn. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., holidays excepted. For added convenience, a drive-up deposit box in the front of the building, as well as one in the lobby of the Tax Collector's Office, are also available.

Taxpayers with questions about their bill may contact the Tax Collector's staff by calling, 530-889-4120, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Windeshausen also noted that an automated phone system is available 24 hours a day to assist taxpayers by calling (530) 889-4120. A parcel number is needed to obtain information through the automated phone system or online.
