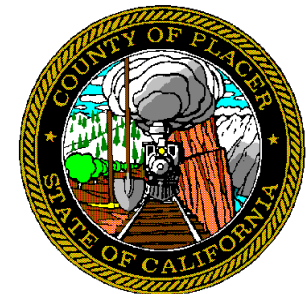

Services Available

The following is a list of services available for adults. All services are “needs-based.” Some services have income eligibility requirements.

Crisis Services-provide urgent outpatient and inpatient evaluation and stabilization for emotional/behavioral issues.

Mental Health Services-includes assessment, brief therapy, case management, support groups, housing assistance, and psychiatric medication support.

Substance Abuse Services-provide education, screening, and treatment for substance abuse.

Adult Protective Services-Investigation and response for the neglect and abuse of the elderly and disabled.

In-Home Supportive Services—

Assistance to the elderly or disabled with services designed to keep individuals safely in their own homes.

Public Guardian/Conservator—

Services designed for the financial and personal protection of those individuals who are deemed “gravely disabled.”

Senior Peer Counseling- Senior Peer Counselor volunteers provide in-home counseling for residents of Placer County aged 55 and older. The content of the counseling is confidential and this is a free service.

Welcome Center- a fun place where anyone can drop-in to enjoy a safe, warm, friendly atmosphere. We are a consumer run program that helps individuals find resources to meet the needs/wants of the community.
