

## **PLACER LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION** **NOTICE OF VACANCY— PUBLIC MEMBER**

**Notice is hereby given** that the Placer Local Agency Formation Commission is accepting applications for the position of public member. The Placer Local Agency Formation Commission is a statutorily created independent regulatory commission that plans and regulates the boundaries of cities and special districts within Placer County. The public member represents the general public on the Commission and is appointed by the other members of the Commission. The public member may not be an employee or officer of Placer County or an employee or officer of any city or any district with territory within Placer County.

The Commission generally meets at 4:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday of each month and is comprised of seven members—two county members, two city members, two special district members and the public member. There is also an alternate for each of the four types of members. The members of the Commission appoint the public member. The appointment is for a term that expires in May of 2015.
