BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- 1. <u>COUNCIL ESTABLISHED:</u> Pursuant to the provisions of the Government Code Section 31010, there is hereby established the Colfax Area Advisory Council.
- 2. <u>TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION:</u> The Council shall represent that territorial area as shown on attached Exhibit 'A'.
- 3. <u>COMPOSITION:</u> The Council shall have five (5) members appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
- 4. PROPERTY OWNERSHIP: Members shall, at the time of appointment and at all times during term of office, be property owners of real property within the area, or business owners or managers operating a business within

such area. Failure to maintain such status shall result in a vacancy in office.

- 5. TERMS OF OFFICE: Members shall serve staggered two calendar year terms. The first such members shall, by lot, determine which two (2) members shall serve a term expiring December 31, 1994, and which three (3) members shall serve a term expiring December 31, 1995. All successors shall serve full two-year terms.
- 6. <u>REMOVAL FROM OFFICE:</u> Any member of the Council may be removed at any time by a 3/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors.
- 7. <u>DUTIES OF COUNCIL:</u> The Council may advise the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern which relate to the area served by the Advisory Council, including but not limited to; land use, public health, safety, public works, law enforcement, and recreation. In addition, the Council shall advise the Board of Supervisors on matters specifically referred to it by the Board of Supervisors for review and recommendation.
- 8. PROCEDURAL RULES: The proceedings and procedures of the Council shall be governed by State law, or, in the absence of applicable State law, by Robert's Rules of Order.
- 9. <u>RECORDS:</u> The Council shall keep all records of its financial transactions in a form prescribed by the Placer County Auditor.
- 10. <u>COMPENSATION:</u> All members of the Council shall serve without compensation.

- 7. PROCEDURAL RULES: The proceedings and procedures of the Council shall be governed by state law, or, in the absence of applicable state law, either by Robert's Rules of Order or by such rules and regulations as the Council shall adopt.
- RECORDS: The Council shall keep all records of its financial transactions in a form prescribed by the Placer County Auditor.
- COMPENSATION: All members of the Council shall serve without compensation.
- 10. <u>NAME CHANGE:</u> The Council shall hereafter be called Weimar/Applegate/Colfax Municipal Advisory Council.
