#### **Grant Application 2013 (FY 2012-13 Allocation)**

The Placer County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (LCBC) is soliciting grant applications from eligible public agencies for disbursement of Placer County's share of State of California Special Distribution Fund monies. The allocation to Placer County in FY 2012-13 is \$66,693.

#### Important:

The Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund Grant Program has been created for local government agencies impacted by tribal gaming, therefore, only those applications that clearly identify and describe impacts from tribal gaming upon such agencies and propose projects designed to mitigate these impacts will be considered for funding by the LCBC.

Applications will be accepted for consideration by the LCBC beginning on Wednesday, March 13, 2013 and must be physically received at the Placer County Executive Office, 175 Fulweiler Ave., Auburn, CA by 5:00 PM on Thursday, April 4, 2013. E-mail, facsimile or other electronic submissions will not be accepted.

The LCBC will review applications and make its selection of recommended projects at a public meeting set for May 1, 2013, 9 am, Placer County Board of Chambers, 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn. Project proposals selected for grant funding by the LCBC will be submitted to the United Auburn Indian Community (UAIC) for its review prior to disbursement of funds from the Office of the State Controller.

All grant recipients must submit to the Placer County Executive Office, by <u>September 1, 2013</u>, a status report on the funded projects. In addition, all grant recipients must submit, by <u>March 28, 2014</u>, a comprehensive written closing report on their funded project/s fulfilling all requirements and documents as stipulated. Additional information regarding reporting requirements will be provided to successful grant applicants. Failure to timely submit both reports will disqualify an entity from the next year's LCBC grant program.
