It has grown in popularity each year attracting 25,000 people last year. The Jubilee provides groups with an excellent opportunity for fund raising while families, visitors and residents enjoy games, food and fun. The funds designated towards this popular event will help to pay for required supplies such as generators, sound systems and lights used throughout the day.


Dear Board Members:
