SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Purchase Order as a Result of a County of Riverside Competitively Awarded Contract with Fire Truck Headquarters for Three Type I Fire Engines in the Total Aggregate Amount of \$1,361,809.90

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the award of a purchase order (PO) as a result of a County of Riverside competitively awarded contract with Fire Truck Headquarters of Oakland for three type I fire engines in the total aggregate amount of \$1,361,809.90, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting PO.

BACKGROUND

On July 26, 2007, Riverside County awarded the purchase of sixteen multi-functional fire engines, as a result of the County's competitive Request for Quote (RFQ) FPARC046, from Smeal Fire Apparatus of Snyder, Nebraska. Placer County Fire (PCF) requested to purchase three fire engines, like the units purchased by the Riverside County, using pricing from Riverside County's contract. These vehicles will be front line engines at the Atwood, Bowman, and Sunset West stations.

Fire Truck Headquarters of Oakland is Smeal's local distributor. The vendor submitted a proposal in the amount of \$464,761.64 for the first engine and \$448,524.13 for each additional unit purchased. The Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e) (3) permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County.

FISCAL IMPACT

The purchase order resulting from this recommendation will total \$1,361,809.90. On April 6, 2010, your Board approved a budget revision for the purchase of the three fire engines and related adjustments to the Master Fixed Asset List. The County Executive Office's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.

The requisition amount is \$1,365,000. The department has budgeted correctly for this purchase and funding is available in the current fiscal year budget. The Engines are on the Master Fixed Asset List, two in Fire Protection Fund (Fund 170) and one in the Special Districts Budget under Fund 501, Subfund 093 – North Auburn Ophir Fire.
