ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Auburn Education Foundation *Grant Program* to benefit the students in the Auburn Union Elementary School District, as requested by Supervisor Holmes (\$250).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the fundraising efforts of the Auburn Education Foundation *Grant Program*. The Auburn Education Foundation raises funds to benefit the students in the Auburn Union Elementary School District. Last year the Foundation was able to provide \$24,500 in classroom and school wide grants, which also assisted them in keeping school libraries open. The funds designated towards this program go directly to the classroom via a grant process ensuring that only qualified projects such as Literacy Comes Alive, Music in Motion, Life Labs and events such as Cain's Crossing Renaissance Faire and the Symphony Goes to School continue.


