### WEST PLACER MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL

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Wednesday, June 13, 2012

A regular meeting of the West Placer Municipal Advisory Council was held on Wednesday, June 13, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at the Creekview Ranch Middle School, Roseville, Ca.

1. Call to Order: the meeting was called to order at 7:00

2. Pledge of Allegiance: Chair John Hottle led the pledge.
3. Approval of the Agenda. Darryl moved to approve the agenda. Walt seconded. Motion carried 3-0
4. Approval of the Minutes of April 11, 2012. Darryl Osborne moved to approve the minutes of April 11, 2012. Walt seconded. Motion carried 3-0.
5. Public comment: Any member of the public may address the Municipal Advisory Council on any matter that is NOT listed on the agenda. Comments will normally be limited to three (3) minutes per person at the discretion of the Chairperson. Marilyn Jasper representing the Sierra club, spoke to the MAC on the subject of "Community Centers" related to land use designations in residential areas on a year round basis. Currently there are 4 applications moving with the Placer County system and the concern is definition of true community center vs. a commercial venue area. Director Michael Johnson has just designated that applications for events will now need to be heard by the local MAC/Planning commission rather than the zoning administrator process. The members present on the board requested that Eric look into this and provide information as needed.
6. Supervisor Report: Eric Goldman (representing Supervisor Duran) reported the County is recently appointed a new CEO, Mr. David Boesch, formerly San Mateo County Manager. He also informed the board that Director Johnson had changed the community center review process (as stated) and that Supervisor Duran was aware of the potential need for term(s) clarification in the process.
7. Public Safety:
  - A. County Sheriff's Department. Officer Bell reported some car break-ins and unlocked sheds.
  - B. Cal-Fire : None present.
  - C. CHP: None present.
8. Informational Item

A Update on the Cook Riolo Bridge, presented by Kellen Prindiville (Public Works) Update on construction of the bridge project and answer any questions from the public. Kellen (bridge project manager) reported that the bridge was finally started with a bid of 6.9 million by MCM construction. It is expected that one lane would be constructed this summer with traffic moved to that area early November for the winter shut-down. The current bridge will remain as a walking bridge until the completion of the second phases in 2013. The speed limit in the construction zone is 25 mph which should aid the reduction of speed on Cook Riolo. There was some discussion on the speed humps/diverter issue with the speed humps not being exactly as expected but rather placing people driving in the middle of the road. Kellen indicated she would report back the issues being faced.
