Introduction by Lisa Carnahan (Planning Services Division); Presentation by John Hodgson (Representative for the Morgan Creek/Morgan Greens HOA)." CDRA is working on n application for the Morgan Creek/Morgan Greens Gated Entrances: "The Morgan Creek/Morgan Greens Gated Entrances Project proposes to add vehicle access gates and an electronic security system at the three entrances to the Morgan Creek community (at Walerga, Vineyard and PFE Roads), and at the one entrance to the Morgan Greens community (Cook Riolo Road). Greeters would be stationed at the Vineyard entrance 24 hours a day/7 days a week/ 365 days a year to monitor access for all four gated entry areas. A greeter would also be placed at the Walerga entrance during daylight hours, and during evening special events at the golf club. This project would require a modification to the Conditional Use Permits for both subdivisions. (15 mins)
