

Placer County HHS Adult System of Care Alcohol and Drug Screening Clinic

Fast Facts:

- Screening clinic is free and open to all Placer County residents.
- Purpose of Screening Clinic is to screen for alcohol and drug issues and make recommendations regarding resources, services and treatment options. Individuals will likely have to cover some or all costs of treatment.
- Some clients will be referred from Screening Clinic to HHS for Assessment and Intake; others will be referred to community treatment programs.
- Placer's treatment approach has five levels:
 - Level One: education and process groups
 - Level Two: outclient groups held 1x per week
 - Level Three: outclient groups held 2 3x's per week
 - Level Four: residential treatment
 - Level Five: aftercare/ relapse prevention group held 1x per week
- Resources will be suggested for clients on a treatment waiting list.
- What should I bring? Bring your Drivers License or other picture ID, documentation of finances and court orders (if applicable)
