ACTION REQUESTED

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked once again to approve appropriations to help support the Loomis Basin Chamber of Commerce *Building Fund*. The Loomis Basin Chamber of Commerce is in the process of constructing a new Chamber office. The town of Loomis is offering a 30-year lease on the land with the modular unit being donated. The funds designated towards this program will help with the costs of permits, utility connections, grading, paving, foundation work, landscaping and signage.
