Subject: **2011/12 SEWER LINE VIDEO INSPECTION, SMD 1 AND SMD 2 -  
PROJECT 08245**

**ACTION REQUESTED/RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the Director of Facility Services or his designee to execute a contract with Coastline Water Resources, Inc. for the 2011/12 Sewer Line Video Inspection, Sewer Maintenance District (SMD) 1 and SMD 2 – Project 08245, in an amount not to exceed \$225,366, and approve any required change orders consistent with the County Purchasing Manual and Section 20142 of the Public Contract Code.

**BACKGROUND:** On January 27, 2009, your Board approved a list of pre-qualified firms to perform sewer line video inspections for sewer collection systems throughout the County. By letter dated November 21, 2011, staff requested cost proposals from the firms on the pre-qualified list with the intention of entering into a contract to provide sewer line video inspection for FY 2011/12. On December 8, 2011, staff received three cost proposals for sewer line video inspection work in SMD 1 and SMD 2. Coastline Water Resources, Inc. provided the lowest cost for the Project with a proposed cost of \$204,877.64 (SMD 1 - \$57,915.66 and SMD 2 - \$146,961.98). The Engineer's Estimate for this work is \$255,508.

The Project includes hydro cleaning and video inspection of approximately 137,946 linear feet of sanitary sewer lines. 38,677 linear feet of sewer line lies within SMD 1 in the North Auburn area and 99,269 linear feet lies within SMD 2 in the Granite Bay area. The goal of the sewer line video inspection is to locate ground water infiltrating into the sewer collection system and to identify repair projects that will minimize this infiltration. The information is also used in Sanitary Sewer Management Plans required by the Regional Water Quality Control Board to develop five and ten-year Capital Improvement Programs.

In order to expedite completion of the Project during the winter months, staff recommends that your Board authorize the Director of Facility Services, or his designee, to execute a contract with Coastline Water Resources, Inc., and approve any required change orders.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE:** Cleaning and inspection of existing sanitary sewer collection lines is categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15301(b) "Existing Facilities" of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The low bid for the Project is \$204,877. Staff recommends a total project budget of \$225,366, which includes an approximate 10% contingency. Funding for this Project is available in the FY 2011/12 Budgets for SMD 1 (\$63,708) and SMD 2 (\$161,658).
