Subject: Agreement between the California Department of Justice Division of Law Enforcement (DLE) and the Placer County Sheriff's Office

Action Requested

Approve the agreement (Exhibit A) between the Placer County Sheriff's Office and DLE and authorize the Sheriff to sign and execute the agreement. The total amount of the agreement is \$166,840. The term of the agreement is from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.

Background

The Sheriff's Office was recently notified that the State will be eliminating several DLE Commander Positions in California including the Task Force Commander assigned to the Placer County Special Investigation Unit (Placer SIU). With the many challenges of Public Safety Realignment (AB 109) the decision was made to continue to fund the Task Force Commander Position with available California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine (Cal-MMET) Program Funding. The total costs for this reimbursement agreement is \$166,840 which covers costs associated with the Task Force Commander salary, benefits and overtime.

Fiscal Impact

Funds are available from the FY 2011-2012 Cal-MMET Program for this agreement. There is no impact to the General Fund.

REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE **PLACER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE** AND
THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE
DIVISION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT

This Reimbursement Agreement (RA) is to establish that the Placer County Sheriff's Office enters into an agreement with the California Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement (DLE) for the purpose of funding the Task Force Commander position for the Placer Special Investigation Unit (PLACER SIU) under the authority of the PLACER SIU Council as agreed per Placer Law Enforcement Agencies (PLEA) MOU dated January 19, 2012.

The Placer County Sheriff's Office enters into an agreement with the DLE, and agrees to reimburse the Department of Justice for the salary of the Task Force Commander Special Agent Supervisor William K. Olson (\$145,585, which also includes Salary, differential pays, and Staff Benefits, Task Force Commander incentive) for the period of **January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012**. The Task Force Commander's salary will be paid by the State of California, Department of Justice. The Placer County Sheriff's Office will then reimburse the DOJ for salary, in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.

Requests for reimbursement shall be made on a monthly basis and should be forwarded to the DLE Headquarters Office as soon as practical after the first month, which follows the month for which reimbursement is requested. Overtime expense invoices will be prepared by the California Department of Justice and provided to the Placer County Sheriff's Office at the following rate; 300 hours per year at (\$70.85 per hour) for period of 12 months (\$21,255) for reimbursement. Funding for this agreement will be provided through FY 2011-2012 California Multi-Jurisdictional Methamphetamine (Cal-MMET) Program funding.

The California Department of Justice shall bill the Placer County Sheriff's Office PO Box 6990, Auburn, CA. 95604 Attention: Janice Gage, for the salary and overtime hours the Task Force Commander (DLE) personnel incurs. The Placer County Sheriff's Office will then reimburse the state with these funds by issuing a check to: California Department of Justice, 1300 "I" Street, Room 810, Sacramento, CA 95814, Attention: Cashiering Unit

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. The Placer County Sheriff's Office and the California Department of Justice, DLE have executed this Reimbursement Agreement through their duly authorized officers effective the day and year set forth herein.
