That the un-codified Allocation of Positions to Department Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:



**Subject:** Position Ordinance

**Action Requested**

Approve the Position Ordinance (Exhibit A) adding 14 new positions and reallocating eight previously unfunded positions, and approve the hiring of 14 new correctional staff. The 14 new positions are a result of anticipated AB 109 Realignment impacts. The additional eight reallocated positions include seven for the Community Oriented Policing (COPS) Hiring Grant, and one Apollo/Remote Access Network (RAN) Program Manager previously approved by your Board.

**Background**

On December 13, 2011 your Board accepted the grant award from the COPS Hiring Grant to fund eight currently unfunded Deputy Sheriff positions, and approved the RAN Spending Plan that included funding for a full-time Apollo Project Manager. Seven of the COPS Deputy Sheriff allocations are being shifted to the Grants Appropriation, while one will remain in the Tahoe Operations Appropriation. The Program Manager position will be filled by using an Information Technology Analyst job classification, created with the funding and reclassification of a Technology Solutions Analyst allocation. Upon your Board's approval the following positions will be reallocated to the Sheriff's Grants Appropriation, as detailed below:

**Sheriff Grants (110-21780)**

Deputy Sheriff Trainee/I/II	from 10 positions	to 17 (Additional 7)
Information Technology Analyst I/II	from 0 positions	to 1 (Additional 1)

**Sheriff Administration & Support (110-21930)**

Deputy Sheriff Trainee/I/II	from 2 positions	to 1 (moved to 21780)
Technology Solutions Analyst I/II	from 3 positions	to 2 (moved to 21780)

**Sheriff Protection & Prevention (110-21800)**

Deputy Sheriff Trainee/I/II	from 104 positions	to 98 (moved to 21780)
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The additional 14 allocations for Fiscal Year 2011-12 Realignment, as reviewed and recommended by the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Executive Committee on December 20, 2011, and approved by your Board on January 10, 2012, are outlined below:

**Sheriff Jail Corrections & Detention (110-22000)**

Administrative Legal Clerk Entry/Journey	from 19 positions	to 26 (Additional 7)
Correctional Officer I/II	from 73 positions	to 80 (Additional 7)

**Fiscal Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the Position Ordinance changes. Funding for these positions has been identified in the COPS Hiring Grant, RAN Spending Plan and the Realignment AB 109 2011 Implementation Plan that was previously approved by your Board.
