SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Competitively Awarded Blanket Purchase Orders with Vulcan Materials for Asphalt Concrete Used for Road Maintenance Projects in the Total Aggregate Amount of \$680,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of competitively awarded blanket purchase orders (BPOs) with Vulcan Materials of Roseville and Grass Valley for asphalt concrete used for road maintenance projects on behalf of the Department of Public Works Road Maintenance Division (DPW) in the total aggregate amount of \$680,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPOs and to transfer funds between BPOs as necessary to meet the County's needs.

BACKGROUND

DPW requires annual BPOs for the as-needed purchase of various types of asphalt concrete for the department's road maintenance projects. On April 5, 2011, your Board approved the award of competitive Bid No. 10057 to Vulcan Materials and authorized the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BP018634 (Vulcan Materials – Roseville Plant) and BP018635 (Vulcan Materials – Grass Valley Plant), both effective for the period of April 1, 2011, through March 31, 2012.

DPW still requires BPOs for these operational materials and submitted requests to renew their BPOs for another one-year term. The vendor agreed to renew at the same pricing and terms. Section 15 of the General Terms and Conditions of Bid No. 10057 allows for the renewal of the existing agreement on a year-to-year basis pending the successful negotiation of the renewal pricing and terms. Placer County Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3(o) also allows for the renewal of a contract based on the vendors' satisfactory contract performance. A separate renewal agreement has been negotiated with Teichert Aggregates for asphalt concrete purchases in Eastern Placer County and has been included in the March 13, 2012 agenda for your Board's approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BPOs resulting from this recommendation will be awarded to Vulcan Materials – Roseville in the maximum amount of \$333,000.00 and Vulcan Materials – Grass Valley in the maximum amount of \$347,000.00, effective for the period of April 1, 2012, through March 31, 2013. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
