SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Purchase Order including installation as a Result of a CMAS (California Multiple Award Schedule) Awarded Contract with Miracle Recreation Equipment Co for a total amount of \$50,989.26

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the Award of a Purchase Order including installation as a Result of a CMAS (California Multiple Award Schedule) Awarded Contract with Miracle Recreation Equipment Co for a total amount of \$50,989.26 and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting PO.

BACKGROUND

Approved by your board on October 11, 2011 was a budget revision to approve a Playground Replacement project No. 4876. This item is a follow up to that action. The department looked at the different playground manufacturers and determined that Miracle Equipment would best meet the requirements and expectations of the County. Miracle Equipment is one of many vendors on the CMAS. They can provide playground equipment and warranty both the installation and equipment if included as part of their services. They have provided bonds and insurance and will ensure that they meet the prevailing wage requirements as well. In accordance with the Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e)(3), County policy permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County.

The work provided by Miracle will include the installation of the playground equipment. This work would normally be a public project and bid out separately. However, if the County were to have the installation bid out then it would void the manufactures warranty on the equipment. In the interests of the County it is appropriate to have the installation provided by Miracle to maintain the warranty. Miracle has agreed to meet all the requirements of a public project such as insurance, bonds, and prevailing wage. Both Facilities and Procurement feel that waiving the public bidding of this installation is the optimum solution to the issue.

FISCAL IMPACT

The purchase order resulting from this recommendation will total \$50,989.26. Facility Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
