BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:

On May 12, 2009, the Placer County Youth Commission was established by unanimous vote of Resolution 2009-116. The resolution requires that an annual report be prepared and delivered to the Board of Supervisors on or about June 1st each year.

The 2011-2012 Commissioners started strong and kept going. In August, they sponsored and were key organizers of "Celebrate Out Loud", a youth resource fair and expo of teen creativity in downtown Auburn. In fall, bylaws were amended to create a three standing committee system for efficient assessment and action on community issues. The Youth Commission improved their connections with the Board by scheduling mid-year one-on-one meetings with Supervisors. Key efforts and activities this year included prevention of teen drinking through local social host ordinances, waste reduction through junk mail reduction, and building understanding, skills and partnerships among diverse your groups by organizing a three-day Youth Summit retreat ito be held this July.

The Youth Commissioners would like to present their annual report to the Board of Supervisors and share their experiences, accomplishments and impacts.
