ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the appointment of Richard Robinson to Seat #2 (representing District 2) as requested by Supervisor Weygandt.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the Placer County Charter Review Committee is to review the County Charter and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors for amendments and/or revisions to the Charter. The County Charter was adopted by voters in 1980 and is a governing document that provides a level of flexibility in local decision making and contains provisions that guide the organizational structure, duties and responsibilities of elected and appointed officials. Section 601 of the County Charter requires the Board of Supervisors to convene a Charter Review Committee within five years of the last review and every five years thereafter. The last review action occurred in November 2007.

The Committee must hold at least two public hearings prior to making final recommendations to the Board of Supervisors. The recommendations of the Committee, if any, are not binding and do not compel the Board to adopt such recommendations. Any proposed changes or additions to the County Charter must be submitted to the voters of the County in the form of ballot measures including the text of the proposed amendments, impartial analysis and arguments.

The 2012 Charter Review Committee will consist of seven members, one appointed by each Supervisor and two At-Large members appointed by consensus of the Board of Supervisors.

PUBLIC COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Placer County Charter Review Committee is to review and evaluate the County Charter and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors of any changes or additions to the Charter. The Committee shall review the Charter and, after at least two public hearings, make recommendations for amendments to or revisions of the Charter to the Board of Supervisors.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST: No

COMPOSITION: The composition of the 2012 Charter Review Committee as determined by the Board of Supervisors is seven members, one appointed by each Supervisor and two At-Large members appointed by consensus of the Board of Supervisors.

MEETINGS: Determined by Chairman of Committee. Two public hearings are required prior to final recommendations by Committee.

COMPENSATION: No direct compensation; however, Committee members may be reimbursed for expenses incurred related to Committee work and public hearings including meals and mileage reimbursement.
