SUBJECT: REVENUE SHARING – Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing (AMIH) to subsidize their Housing Program for the mentally ill, as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$250).

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing (AMIH) *Housing Program* to subsidize the mentally ill in their housing program, as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$250).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing (AMIH) *Housing Program*. AMIH is a non-profit organization serving mental health clients of the Placer County Adult System of Care, who are in need of housing, food, transportation, counseling, independent living skills training and much more. This program is designed to assess and intensively support consumers for ninety days with the goal to transition residents to Level II or Supportive Semi-Independent Housing. The more intensive services allow mental health consumers transitioning out of board and care homes, hospitals, and higher levels of care a greater opportunity for success. The funds designated towards this popular program will be used to subsidize the mentally ill in their housing program.
