## ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

1. Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute and sign the 2012-13 Local Transportation Fund (LTF) Bicycle/Pedestrian Claim to be submitted to the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA) for Placer County Transit in the amount of \$250,000. There is no net county cost.

## BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

At the discretion of the Board, PCTPA typically allocates 2 percent of the LTF for bicycle and pedestrian facilities. PCTPA works with staff of the six cities and the County of Placer to develop a cash management plan with a five-year horizon. Allocations are made to each jurisdiction based on existing and projected future population.

Staff is recommending that Placer County allocate \$250,000 from the Local Transportation Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund apportioned by PCTPA to Placer County Department of Public Works projects PC2920 Douglas Blvd & Sierra College Blvd Bike Pedestrian Facilities and Lane in the amount of \$25,000 and PC2953 Auburn Folsom Bikeway (Joe Rodgers to Douglas) in the amount of \$225,000 for FY2012-13. These Bicycle/Pedestrian Funds will supplement Federal grants to fully fund these projects.

In order for Placer County to receive the funds, it is necessary for your Board to execute a claim requesting the Local Transportation Bicycle/Pedestrian Funds. A Local Transportation Fund Bicycle/Pedestrian Claim totaling \$250,000 is attached for signature by the Chair and will be submitted to PCTPA on behalf of the Department of Public Works.

## ENVIRONMENTAL

The proposed action is not a project as defined by Public Resources Code Section 21065 and is therefore exempt from environmental review under CEQA.

## FISCAL IMPACT

The funds will be used on PC2920 Douglas Blvd and Sierra College Bike Pedestrian Facilities and Lane and PC2953 Auburn Folsom Bikeway (Joe Rodgers to Douglas) and have been budgeted in the 2012-13 Fiscal Year Budget.
