RE: Review Local Agency Conflict of Interest Codes - Biennial Report

ACTION REQUESTED:

Adopt the attached resolution acknowledging statements from local government agencies regarding the status of their conflict of interest codes and approving amendments to those designated agencies' codes as indicated in the attached resolution.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Political Reform Act, the Placer County Board of Supervisors is the conflict of interest code reviewing body for local agencies, other than cities, that are located wholly within Placer County to ensure compliance with State law.

Each even-numbered year, the local agencies are required to submit a report to the County indicating whether their conflict of interest code is sufficient or requires amendment. This office has provided the required notice to the agencies on behalf of your Board, and has reviewed the responses to determine whether they are legally adequate.

All agencies have responded to our notice. We have reviewed each of the responses and find the documents submitted to be in compliance with the law. Those responses and amendments have been placed on file in the office of the Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters, and copies are also available for review at the Clerk of the Board's office.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached resolution approving the conflict of interest code reports and amendments from the designated agencies.
