**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLACER, STATE OF  
CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:**

**Section 1:** Section 2.56.030 in Article 2.56 of Chapter 2 of the Placer County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**2.56.030      Composition**

The bond screening committee shall consist of:

- A. The director of public works, ~~who is chairperson of the committee;~~
- B. The county assessor;
- C. The director of the department of health and human services;

- D. The director of the department of facility services;
- E. The county executive officer;
- F. The planning director;
- G. The county treasurer-tax collector;
- H. The county auditor/controller;
- I. The director of the community development resources agency;**
- J. The director of engineering services for the community development resources agency.**

**The members of the committee shall select a chairperson and a vice-chairperson by majority vote.**

**Section 2:** Section 2.56.040 in Article 2.56 of Chapter 2 of the Placer County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**2.56.040 Members may designate deputies subordinates to sit on the committee—Powers of deputies subordinates as members.**

Any officer named in Section 2.56.030 may, **from time-to-time**, designate one of his or her deputies subordinates to act as member of the bond screening committee in his or her place or stead to all intents and purposes as though the officer were personally present, including the right of the deputy subordinate to be counted in constituting a member to participate in the proceedings of the committee and to vote upon any and all matters.

**Section 3:** The foregoing specified ordinance amendments shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of final passage of this ordinance.
