

Subject: Ratification of Build-up for new transportation van

ACTION REQUESTED

Your approval is requested to ratify the payment for materials and installation to S & G Enterprises for the build-up of the new transportation van for the Sheriff's Tahoe Operations in an amount not-to-exceed \$9,000.

BACKGROUND

Your Board approved the replacement of a new transportation van for the Sheriff's Department Tahoe Operations. The van is used to transport inmates. Costs approved included the appropriate build-up necessary to safely transport inmates. The receipt of the new van was delayed because it was not originally delivered as specified and had to be returned. The old van was inspected by Fleet Services and pulled as being unsafe to drive. Transporting inmates in the interim to accommodate safety and classification needs was becoming increasingly more difficult. When the new van finally arrived, staff felt getting it in-service an urgent matter. They immediately initiated action to build up the van. The vendor responded to our request immediately so that the parts needed could be ordered and expedite placing the van in-service. The invoice for materials is \$3,582 and the installation quote is \$5,321 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$8,903. The parts have been confirmed by Procurement with installation to follow to assure the vendor can be paid for the services provided. Your Board's approval is requested to ratify the payment to S & G Enterprises.

FISCAL IMPACT

The costs to build up the transportation van are in the current budget. There is no additional fiscal impact.
