**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approve the agreement for FY 2005/06 in the amount of \$113,620 and any amendments during the term of the agreement with Placer County Office of Education Community Challenge Grant.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Community Challenge Grant (CCG) Program was legislatively enacted in 1996 as part of the Governor's Initiative, Partnership for Responsible Parenting. Challenge Grants promote community-based partnerships aimed at reducing unwed and teen pregnancies. The California Department of Health Services funds these youth development programs. CCG is a collaborative effort with nine Placer County collaborators with grants from the Placer County Office of Education, as lead agency. The local program targets youth ages 12-19 residing in Lincoln, North Tahoe/Kings Beach and central Roseville. Youth are identified through the education system, Health and Human Services programs, court, community schools and local community based programs. Placer County Office of Education subcontracts with Placer County Health and Human Services to provide funding for a part-time community specialist (Client Services Practitioner II) and a part-time program health educator. The agreement is being submitted late because we did not receive the paperwork from the Placer County Office of Education until after January 20, 2006 and also due to the need for changes in the contractual language.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The total amount for the 2005-06 agreement is \$113,620.00. Funds have been budgeted and are used for personnel costs, operating expenses, transportation, travel and training. The grant does require a non-governmental match. Placer County Office of Education, as the lead agency for the grant, provides the match through in-kind contributions from other collaborators. There is no direct general fund contribution.
