SUBJECT: GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT WITH THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY

ACTION REQUESTED

It is respectfully requested that your Board adopt a resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to sign and approve an award agreement and authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to enter the County into any necessary contractual obligations to execute said award agreement. The proposed Office of Traffic Safety Grant Agreement will provide funding for projects and services targeting DUI offenders in an amount not to exceed \$450,000.

BACKGROUND

In January 2006, the Probation Department applied for a grant, "Intensive DUI Supervision Services Project", with the Office of Traffic Safety. On June 12, 2006, we met with Leslie Witten-Rood, OTS Regional Coordinator, who advised that the Placer County Probation Department was awarded the grant in the amount of \$450,000. Funding is available to pay for projects and services targeting DUI offenders. The grant will provide intensive services and operations inclusive of: Eighty hours of overtime per month for the duration of the grant for increased supervision, officer training, supervision technology, supervision equipment, and community education. This will allow the Probation Department, in conjunction with our DUI Symposium partners, to enhance our County DUI operations and develop responses and resources to increase public safety in the community that we serve.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total grant award is \$450,000 covering the period from October 1, 2006, to December 31, 2008. This grant will have no net effect on the Probation Department or County budgets during this time frame.
