The concept of a "Sober Grad Night" originated in 1993 with the primary goal being to offer graduating Seniors a fun evening in one location **as an alternative to drinking and driving**. It is the goal of Senior parents that this Grad Night be a memorable one for our teenagers, and your support would be greatly appreciated.


The parents of the current seniors raise the money. Historically the budget for Sober Grad is approximately \$25,000. This is also our goal. Funding for Sober Grad usually comes from local businesses, private donations, fundraising, and the sale of the tickets to students. The money will be used for prizes, food, decorations, entertainment, senior t-shirts, paper goods, postage, printing and miscellaneous fees.

Sober Grad is held the evening of graduation, which will be June 8, 2007. The money will be raised and spent by June 7, 2006. In the past, approximately 92-95% of those students in the graduating class have attended Sober Grad Night. We are hoping for those same statistics or higher. We currently have 268 seniors, up from last year, at Lincoln High School.

Sober Grad is good for not only the students, but also the community. It exemplifies volunteerism and cooperation between businesses, parents, police department and school district. No one is paid for their participation and instead work together for the good of the "kids". We strongly believe that this event can and will save lives. It also encourages the Senior class of 2007 to get together for the last time and have fun in a safe setting.
