**ACTION REQUESTED:**

The Older Adult Advisory Commission (OAAC) respectfully requests that the Board of Supervisors accept the resignation of Esther L. Hogans from Seat #13 (Minority Representative) and declare Seat #16 (Senior Service Organization) vacant, vacated by Deborah Nagel, so that recruitment for these positions may begin immediately.

**BACKGROUND:**

The OAAC provides a voice for older adults in county government. The Commission advises the Board of Supervisors and the Department of Health and Human Services on matters relating to the creation and delivery of services promoting well-being and quality of life for older adults. The Board of Supervisors appoints members to the OAAC upon recommendation of the Commission.

Esther L. Hogans holds Seat #13 on the OAAC, which is designated for a Minority Representative. Ms. Hogans has submitted her resignation to the Commission. In her letter of resignation, dated November 3, 2006, she states her resignation is effective immediately. Ms. Hogans indicates that her resignation is due to health constraints. Ms. Hogans' letter of resignation is attached for your reference.

Deborah Nagle holds Seat #16 on the OAAC, which is designated for a Senior Service Organization Representative. Ms. Nagle recently resigned her position with Senior Independent Services and she is no longer attending Commission meetings. Since Ms. Nagle no longer represents a Senior Service Organization, and is no longer attending Commission meetings, the OAAC recommends that her seat (#16) be vacated in order that recruitment for a Senior Service Organization representative may begin. A letter from Senior Independent Services' Interim Executive Director is attached for your reference.

This action has no fiscal impact to the County General Fund.


