SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. 13415 with Pro Tech Monitoring, Inc. for GPS Electronic Monitoring Service in the Maximum Amount of \$100,000.00.

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. 13415 with Pro Tech Monitoring, Inc. of Odessa, Florida for GPS Electronic Monitoring Service on behalf of the Probation Department in the maximum amount of \$100,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

BACKGROUND

The Probation department has requested the renewal of their satellite monitoring and tracking BPO with Pro Tech under WSCA Contract 14600, competitively awarded by the State of Washington on January 1, 2002 and in effect through January 8, 2009. On January 24, 2006 your Board approved the extension of BPO 13415 with Pro Tech Monitoring Systems Inc. for the remote satellite tracking and monitoring of low to medium risk offenders. The current estimate of offenders that will be using this program is eighty (80) to one hundred (100). Should Proposition 89 be implemented as law in January of 2007, the Probation Department expects the need for these services to expand, as Proposition 89 requires satellite monitoring of all sex offenders. PPM 1.3(e)(3) states that competitive bidding is not required when an existing contract for the same service or products desired by the County has been competitively awarded by another public agency. The WSCA contract meets this criterion.

This BPO will be effective January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Probation Department has budgeted appropriately for their anticipated expenditures.
