SUBJECT: Approve the attached resolution authorizing the County Clerk to render election services for the election to be held June 6, 2006 for the Gubernatorial Primary Election for the Grant Joint Union High School District and Sacramento Municipal Utility District.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the County Clerk to render election services for the Grant Joint Union High School District and Sacramento Municipal Utility District on June 6, 2006.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year.

On or about February 17, 2006, the Sacramento County Clerk and the Placer County Clerk received a resolution from the Grant Joint Union High School District calling for a measure to be put before the registered voters in their district in Sacramento and Placer Counties. Grant Joint Union High School District is shared with Sacramento and Placer Counties, with Sacramento as the lead county.

On or about March 3, 2006, the Sacramento County Clerk and the Placer County Clerk received a resolution from Sacramento Municipal Utility District calling for a measure to be put before the registered voters in their district in Sacramento and Placer Counties. Sacramento Municipal Utility District is shared with Sacramento and Placer Counties, with Sacramento as the lead county.

Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that special district and school Governing Bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to said Bodies on a reimbursable basis. For the County Clerk to perform the functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code 5303, the County Clerk needs approval of this resolution from the Board of Supervisors.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for a list of jurisdictions seeking election and requested ballot measures.

FISCAL IMPACT

Requesting jurisdictions will pay for these special elections based on the approved fee schedule for election services.

WHEREAS, the Grant Joint Union High School District has called for a special election for a bond measure.

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Municipal Utility District has called for a special election for a measure for proposed ordinance.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10002 of the Elections Code and Section 5303 of the Education Code, the Governing Bodies of Special Districts and School Districts may request the Board of Supervisors to call elections and permit the County Clerk to render specified services to said Bodies relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Grant Joint Union High School District Special Election and the Sacramento Municipal Utility District Special Election be consolidated and held as detailed on "Exhibit A"; and

MEASURE G

Grant Joint Union High School District

“To build and renovate school libraries, install fire safety equipment, remove hazardous materials for student health and safety, upgrade electrical systems to support classroom computers, replace outdated plumbing, repair leaking roofs, build new classrooms to reduce overcrowding, and make other specified school facility improvements, shall Grant Joint Union High School District issue \$230 million in bonds, at legal interest rates, with independent citizen oversight, all funds benefiting local schools and no funds going to administrator salaries or the State?”

MEASURE H

Sacramento Municipal Utility District

“Shall it be the established policy of the Sacramento Municipal Utility District to obtain the opinion of its current voters, through a non-binding advisory vote, on proposals pertaining to expansion of the boundaries of the District by annexation?”
