Dear Mr. Weygandt,

The concept of a "LHS Sober Grad Night" began in 1993 with the primary goal of being able to offer graduating Seniors a fun filled evening in one location as an alternative to drinking and driving. It is the goal of the Steering Committee and Senior parents that this Grad Night be a memorable one for the students.

The parents of the current seniors raise the money. Historically the budget for Sober Grad is approximately \$25,000. This is also our goal. Funding for Sober Grad usually comes from local businesses, private donations, fundraising, and the sale of the tickets to students. The money will be used for prizes, food, decorations, entertainment, senior t-shirts, paper goods, postage and printing and miscellaneous fees.

Sober Grad is held the evening of graduation, which will be June 9, 2006. All of the money will be raised and spent by June 30, 2006. In the past, approximately 92-95% of the students in the graduating class have attended Sober Grad Night. We are hoping for those same statistics or higher. We currently have 247 seniors at Lincoln High School.

Sober Grad is good for the community because it demonstrates the spirit of volunteerism and cooperation that this town is so well known for. No one is paid for their participation and instead work together for the good of the "kids". We strongly believe that this event can and will save lives. It also encourages the Senior class of 2006 to get together for the last time and have fun in a safe setting.

This event is a very worthy cause. It supports the students and the community. It exemplifies volunteerism and cooperation between businesses, parents, police department and the school district. Sober Grad would be very honored to qualify as one of your recipients.
