BACKGROUND

Todd Barber, on behalf of Global Event Management, has applied to Caltrans for a Temporary Encroachment Permit to conduct a special swimming, biking and running triathlon competition on Saturday September 16, 2006 in and around Kings Beach State Recreation Area called “The Lake Tahoe Triathlon”.

This is the second year for this event and is expected once again to be popular with the triathlon enthusiasts in the Lake Tahoe area. A portion of the proceeds will benefit the local DARE program. This event will also generate a significant economic impact throughout the community in the form of lodging, restaurant and retail revenues.

WHEREAS, Todd Barber, on behalf of Global Event Management, has applied to Caltrans for a Temporary Encroachment Permit to conduct a special swimming, biking and running triathlon competition on Saturday September 16, 2006 at Lake Tahoe called "The Lake Tahoe Triathlon"; and

WHEREAS, this event will have a charitable component with a portion of the proceeds benefiting the local DARE chapter; and

WHEREAS, the race begins in the Kings Beach State Recreation Area for the swimming portion of the event; and

WHEREAS, the event will include the following route: After the swimming segment of the competition, athletes will mount their bikes and proceed onto State Highway Route 28 (westbound) at the intersection of Coon Street and State Highway Route 28, turn right at the intersection of Highway Route 267 and proceed up State Highway Route 267 to Brockway Summit, where they will cross the highway at Mt. Watson Road. The bikers will then proceed down State Highway Route 267 and turn west onto State Highway Route 28, continuing to the second Lake Forest Road entrance to proceed along the Lake Forest Road and turn around in the Skylandia Beach North entrance parking lot to ride back along Lake Forest Road and turn right onto State Highway Route 28. They will end back at the starting point at Coon Street and State Highway Route 28 in King's Beach. The athletes will park their bikes in the transition area at the Coon Street parking lot to begin the final stage of the race; and

WHEREAS, the athletes will begin the running segment of the competition by running westbound on State Highway Route 28 and turning onto State Highway Route 267. From this point, the athletes will turn at the intersection of Pinedrop Avenue and State Highway Route 267 running along the existing bike path into the North Tahoe Regional Park and follow an existing trail loop to leave North Tahoe Regional Park as they run down National Avenue and turn onto State Highway Route 28. The runners will continue eastbound on State Highway Route 28 back to Kings Beach where they will turn left onto the walkway in front of the Kings Beach Conference Center and cross the finish line on the beach; and

WHEREAS, assistance is required by the CHP at all street crossings for safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, approximately 100 volunteers will be positioned along the biking and running routes during the race. Volunteers will be positioned at each intersection and stationed at the entry of each business along the route to assist with any vehicular issues; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the CHP Officers and volunteers, numerous signs and orange cones will be placed along the entire course and flyers will be given to each home and business along the route notifying them of the race one week prior to the event.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Placer County Board of Supervisors goes on record in support of the "Lake Tahoe Triathlon" and requests that it be conducted per the terms and conditions set forth by Caltrans in their Encroachment Permit to maintain the safety of the motoring public.
