SUBJECT: TRANSIT MOU - PRIDE INDUSTRIES/CTSA

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the Board Chairman to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with PRIDE Industries for transit services.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

PRIDE Industries serves as the designated Consolidated Transportation Services Agency (CTSA) for Placer County. In that role, PRIDE Industries has provided Dial-A-Ride and shuttle services to support and augment the Placer County Transit (PCT) routes for the past six years. This arrangement was developed as part of the Short-Range Transit Plan adopted by the Board of Supervisors in September of 2000 and is consistent with the Short-Range Transit Plan adopted by the Board in July 2005.

Pursuant to the MOU, the CTSA provides three services: 1) Dial-A-Ride service in the Loomis and Rocklin area; 2) Dial-A-Ride service in Granite Bay; and, 3) a deviated route shuttle on Taylor Road between Auburn and Sierra College. These services meet the Americans With Disabilities Act requirements for accessible paratransit services as well as provide service in areas where there are no PCT bus routes. This MOU is for FY 2006/07.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This project is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 21080(b)(10), as it is a project to provide passenger service.

FISCAL IMPACT

Placer County will pay PRIDE Industries \$220,490 for transit service in Rocklin, Loomis and the County. The City of Rocklin and the Town of Loomis will reimburse the County \$115,772 for service within their jurisdictions. The remaining \$104,718 will be funded by County Transportation Development Act funds for service in the County. These expenses and revenues are included in the FY 2006/07 budget.
