**BACKGROUND**

This is an ongoing program administrated by the State Board of Control, renamed California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board. This Joint Powers Agreement allows the District Attorney, Victim/Witness Department, to provide verification and payment for services provided to Victims of Crime in Placer County. Monies allocated to this program by the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board for the fiscal years 2007/2008 are \$267,600 for fiscal year 2008/2009 are \$267,600.

WHEREAS, the Placer County Board of Supervisors has designated the Placer County District Attorney Victim Center as the provider of major and comprehensive victim and witness services in Placer County; and

WHEREAS, the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board has selected Placer County District Attorney-Victim Assistance Center to receive "Joint Powers" monies for the purpose of verification of victim claims; and

WHEREAS, the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board has selected the Placer County District Attorney to receive \$267,600 for fiscal year 2007/2008 and \$267,600 for fiscal year 2008/2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the District Attorney is authorized, on its behalf, to sign the attached Joint Powers Agreement with the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board to receive monies to operate a Victim Assistance Center and is further authorized to sign for purposes of making any extension or amendment thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body and shall hold the State Board of Control harmless from any claims that arise from the use of grant monies.
