SUBJECT: Angora Fire – Receive a report on the Angora Fire in South Lake Tahoe and direct staff to review existing ordinances and possible future ordinances to enhance fire safety.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Receive a report from Supervisor Kranz on the recent Angora Fire that occurred in South Lake Tahoe and provide appropriate direction to staff.

BACKGROUND:

As your Board is aware, a recent fire in the South Lake Tahoe area caused significant damage. According the Governor's Office of Emergency Services, the fire burned approximately 3,100 acres with the loss of more than 250 homes and many outbuildings.

This presentation will provide information to your Board for discussion on identifying and exploring opportunities in ordinances in terms of what Placer County might implement, and within the context of those related rules and regulations as may be mandated or adopted by other regulatory agencies.

FISCAL IMPACT:

At this preliminary point, staff work in reviewing local ordinances and coordinating with other regulatory agencies to determine potential courses of action will be absorbed within existing allocations. At some point in the future and depending on direction and scope of work authorized by your Board in this effort, additional allocations may be requested.
