Action Requested/Recommendation

Accept the Appointment of Eugene Freeland, Veterans of Foreign Wars of South Placer Post 904 to the Veterans Advisory Council, effective immediately.

Background

Mr. Freeland has been an active member of the Placer County Veterans Advisory Council since May 2001 with Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1942, Auburn. Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1942/Auburn and Post 904/Loomis have now merged and the Commander of the consolidated post wishes to have Mr. Freeland be the representative for the newly consolidated post. He has long been active in organizations representing veterans and he works diligently to assist veterans.

Action Requested/Recommendation

Accept the Appointment of Richard Osgood, Veterans of Foreign Wars of Colfax Post 1213 to the Veterans Advisory Council, effective immediately.

Background

Mr. Osgood was an active member of the Placer County Veterans Advisory Council in years past before relocating to Oregon. Mr. Osgood has relocated back to the Colfax area and the Commander of the Colfax Post appointed him as the Colfax Post service officer to replace Mr. Harry Green.
