ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution accepting the subject project as complete and authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute the Notice of Completion.

BACKGROUND

The Board authorized the award of Construction Contract No. 73221 to CC Meyers, Inc. for the amount of \$1,399,999 and authorized the Director of Public Works to execute Contract Change Orders up to 15% of the contract amount. Work on this Contract was complete on June 6, 2007. The purpose of this project was to replace the existing, deteriorating bridge that did not meet design standards. The project was completed with minimal effect to traffic.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE

A mitigated negative declaration was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for this project and was approved by your Board on June 30, 2005. A Notice of Determination was also completed for this project. Environmental Clearance was also obtained through the Federal NEPA process.

FISCAL IMPACT

The construction contract was awarded for \$1,399,999.00 with a contingency of \$209,999.90 for a total encumbrance of \$1,609,998.90. The Department has determined the final estimated construction cost for this project was \$1,543,388.80. There were 11 Contract Change Orders (CCO) issued during this project amounting to \$146,600.50. Contract data and CCO summaries are attached as Exhibit "A". The project was funded through the Federal HBRR Program (88.53%) and County Traffic Mitigation Fees and Road Funds (11.47%). Funding for construction of the project was included in the 2005/2006 and 2006/2007 Fiscal Year Budgets.
