SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. 14352 Awarded from a Competitively Bid Public Agency Cooperative Contract with Auburn Tire Service for Passenger Car, Truck, and Heavy Equipment Tires in the Maximum Amount of \$205,000.00

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the renewal of Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 14352 awarded from a competitively bid public agency cooperative contract with Auburn Tire Service for passenger car, truck, and heavy equipment tires in the maximum amount of \$205,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

**BACKGROUND**

The Department of Public Works (DPW), Fleet Services has an ongoing requirement for a wide range of passenger car, truck, and heavy equipment tires. DPW has found it beneficial to contract with a local firm that is able to offer State of California contract prices for a variety of tire manufacturers' brands.

The State of Utah, on the behalf of the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) established a competitively bid, multi-state cooperative contract for tires, inner tubes, and services. The State of California elected to participate and make this contract available to all State agencies and local government agencies. The WSCA contract with Auburn Tire that Placer County is using is effective through February 28, 2008. The State of California is working with the State of Utah to verify a four year contract extension. DPW has requested to renew BP014352 with Auburn Tire Service for the Bridgestone/Firestone, Michelin, and Goodyear tire brands. The requested BPO will be effective from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, or final expiration of the cooperative contract, which ever comes first.

In accordance with the Purchasing Policy Manual (PPM) Section 1.3 (e)(3), County policy allows for an exception to the competitive bidding process when goods and services are obtainable from a private vendor which has a competitively awarded contract with another public agency.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will total \$205,000.00. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
