SUBJECT: Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) resolution

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer, or the chairperson of the Board of Supervisors, to submit and/or sign Placer County's Youthful Offender Block Grant application and related contracts, amendments, or extensions with the State of California. Placer County is allocated \$147,000 as designated in statute.

BACKGROUND

In 2007, Governor Schwarzenegger signed legislation that appropriated state funds to support a broad spectrum of county probation services targeting appropriate rehabilitative and supervision services to youthful offenders, including, all necessary services related to the custody and parole of the offenders. Placer County is allocated \$147,000 as designated in statute.

The legislation directed the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) to administer these funds, and CDCR entrusted the Corrections Standards Authority (CSA) with this responsibility. For administrative purposes, the CSA refers to this effort as the Youthful Offender Block Grant (YOBG) Program. CSA requires each County to submit a resolution from its Board of Supervisors authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to enter into an agreement for these monies.

The YOBG Program replaces services previously provided by the State of California through the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ - previously the California Youth Authority or CYA). The appropriation for each County is based on the number of minors due to be released back to each County and is expected to increase annually for the next two years.

Placer's allocation is accounted for in the current budget, and will continue to be used in support of probation services for youths who previously would have been in a DJJ facility or under DJJ care and supervision.

All funds allocated to counties through the YOBG Program are intended to support the delivery of services authorized by the enabling legislation.
