SUBJECT: Approve the Award of Competitive Bid No. 9746 to T&B Sales for a 10 Wheel Water Truck in the Maximum Amount of \$132,593.63

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the award of competitive Bid No. 9746 to T&B Sales for a 10 wheel water truck in the maximum amount of \$132,593.63, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting purchase order (PO).

BACKGROUND

The Procurement Services Division, on behalf of the Department of Public Works (DPW), Fleet Services, solicited bids for a ten wheel water truck to be used during road maintenance projects. Sixteen vendors were notified of Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 9746 which was also posted on the County's website. The IFB stated that the County intends to purchase one ten wheel water truck in accordance with the Bid's specifications. Bids were received from eight dealers: Interstate Truck Center, Riverview International Trucks, Sacramento Kenworth, Sacramento Truck Center, Santex Truck Center, T&B Sales, Western Truck Center, and Western Truck Parts and Equipment.

Bid evaluation was based on the lowest unit price, warranty cost to upgrade, local vendor's preference, and early payment discount. No registered Placer County local vendors responded to the solicitation. Based on their complete responsiveness to the bid requirements and lowest price, staff recommends approval to award the resulting PO to T&B Sales of Rialto, CA for one Sterling LT 9500 model water truck with warranty upgrades in the maximum amount of \$132,593.63.

FISCAL IMPACT

The PO resulting from this recommendation will provide one 10 wheel water truck for the Placer County Department of Public Works (DPW), Fleet Services in the maximum amount of \$132,593.63. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
