ACTION REQUESTED

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Woodcreek High School *Band Boosters Club* efforts to purchase a trailer. Woodcreek High School supplies buses for transporting the students, but the cargo area is insufficient to transport all of the instruments, uniforms and accessories the band requires to perform at various competition and exhibition events. The Boosters Club has been renting moving vans and trailers in past years consuming a large portion of the funds raised. The funds designated towards this program will be used for the purchase of the trailer.

A trailer belonging to the band would support many class years and increase the opportunities for the band students. The Boosters club has been renting moving vans and trailers in past years consuming a large portion of the funds raised. The school supplies buses for transporting the students, but the cargo area is insufficient to transport all of the instruments, uniforms and accessories. The Band program is growing and currently consists of many component bands: 2 jazz bands, a marching band, a color guard team, a symphonic band, a drum line, a street percussion, and a winter percussion.

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Competition fees have been increasing. The school pays for some. The Boosters club supplements those costs, and the ability to use funds that had been previously designated for truck or trailer rental will increase the opportunities of the various band groups to perform. The trailer that will meet our needs has a total cost of \$6,485.97 out the door. A flyer and cost estimate is attached. Any amount that you determine to contribute to our cause is greatly appreciated and will be used for the specified purpose. When all necessary funds are received, the trailer will be purchased.
