SUBJECT: Approve Resolution to Authorize the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to Render Election Services for Elections to be Held June 3, 2008.

Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render election services for the elections to be held June 3, 2008.

Background

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in June each even-numbered year. Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that cities, special district and school district governing bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the county elections official to render necessary election services to said agencies on a reimbursable basis.

Issue Statement

For the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to perform the requested functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code 5303, approval of your Board of Supervisors is required, and a resolution ordering the June 3, 2008 election is attached.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for a list of jurisdictions seeking election services and requested ballot measures.

Fiscal Impact

Requesting local jurisdictions will pay for their special elections based on the approved fee schedule for election services. Costs necessary for conducting the elections for federal, state, and countywide offices have been budgeted for in the current FY 2007-08 budget for the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters.

MEASURES

Measure K—Northstar Community Services District

Shall the Northstar Community Services District be authorized to levy a special tax for the NCSD Fuels Management Program on all real properties within the District in the sum of \$209.03, provided said special tax may be adjusted annually, beginning on July 1, 2009, using the Consumer Price Index for San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose. Said tax is to be collected with Placer County General Taxes commencing with the forthcoming 2008/2009 fiscal year and continuing each year thereafter.

Measure L—Tahoe Truckee Unified School District

To improve energy efficiency, replace portable classrooms, upgrade computer and instructional technology, expand career and vocational classrooms, meet seismic safety and snow load requirements, shall Facilities Improvement District No.1 of the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District issue \$95,800,000 of bonds at legal rates to renovate, acquire, construct, repair and equip Truckee area schools, sites and facilities, with required independent public financial audits, citizens' oversight, no money for administrators' salaries?

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
