

Each year 160,000 children are diagnosed worldwide and despite tremendous progress, events like these are important to help find a cure. The Keaton Raphael Memorial charity in conjunction with the St Baldrick's Foundation coordinates this local St. Patrick's Day national head shaving event. This year's event takes place on March 29 at the Westfield Galleria. Again, the funds designated towards this popular event benefit childhood cancer research.
