SUBJECT: Call for the Election of Governing Board Members for the Suburban Pines Community Services District to be Consolidated with the November 4, 2008 General Election

Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution calling for an election of governing board members for the Suburban Pines Community Services District to be consolidated with the November 4, 2008 Presidential General Election.

Background

At the November 7, 2006 Gubernatorial General Election, there were no candidates for the Suburban Pines Community Services District, leaving the District with only two board members. The two remaining board members did not take action to have board members appointed or elected to fill the vacancies. In April 2007, the two remaining board members resigned, leaving the Community Services District without a board.

Elections Code Section 10004 provides that the Board of Supervisors may order an election for the selection of governing board members of a special district if the governing body of the special district fails to call or take any other steps necessary to the holding of the regular district election at which any members of the governing body are to be selected.

The attached resolution would call for an election to select members of the governing body of the Suburban Pines Community Services District consolidated with the November 4, 2008 Presidential General Election.

Fiscal Impact

The Suburban Pines Community Services District will pay for the actual cost of their district elections as provided for in Elections Code Section 10004 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A.

WHEREAS, there is presently no governing body of the Suburban Pines Community Services District and no action has been taken to hold the regular district election at which members of the governing body of the District are to be selected; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10004 of the Elections Code, the Placer County Board of Supervisors may call an election within the District for the selection of the governing board members of the District if the governing body of the special district fails to call or take any other steps necessary to the holding of the regular district election at which any members of the governing body are to be selected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors that an election be held in the Suburban Pines Community Services District on November 4, 2008 for the nomination of candidates to the governing body of the District.

2. Said directors for the District are to be elected at large by the registered voters of the District.

3. The length of the Candidate Statement of Qualifications shall not exceed 200 words. The Candidate Statement shall be paid for by the candidate.

4. In the case of a tie vote, the elections shall be determined by lot.

5. The County Clerk is requested to provide election services. The District will pay all applicable costs of the election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election is to be consolidated with any other applicable election held on the same date.
