SUBJECT: **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, INSPECTION, MATERIALS TESTING AND RELATED SERVICES FOR THE STATE ROUTE 65 / SUNSET BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE PROJECT, CONTRACT NO. 1057**

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chairman of the Board to execute a Professional Services Agreement with PSOMAS, in an amount not to exceed \$2,567,458 for construction management, inspection, materials testing and related services for State Route 65 / Sunset Boulevard Interchange Project; and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve and sign contract amendments for additional professional services not to exceed 10% of the contract amount.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Highway 65 Joint Powers Authority (JPA) is proposing to replace the current at-grade signalized intersection with a grade-separated partial cloverleaf interchange with six lane over-crossing at Sunset Blvd and State Route 65 with the Department of Public Works (DPW) as the project lead. The project will reduce traffic congestion, accidents and delays. The project will allow for the future expansion of State Route 65 to eight lanes with auxiliary lanes and will accommodate the increased traffic demand generated by existing and approved development in the project area of south Placer County.

The interchange project is funded by the Highway 65 JPA which is comprised of Placer County and the Cities of Rocklin and Roseville.

The County issued a Request for Proposals for Construction Management Services for the Sunset Boulevard Interchange on State Route 65 on February 15, 2008. PSOMAS was the Consultant selected through a formal proposal process in response to County Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 9781.

The current project schedule is to begin construction in the fall of 2008 barring any unforeseen circumstances with right of way acquisition and utility coordination. An estimated 18-24 month construction period is expected to complete the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The Placer County BOS approved the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the construction of this project and a Notice of Determination was filed on May 23, 2006.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost for the State Route 65 / Sunset Boulevard Interchange Project is estimated to be \$31,000,000. The total cost for the Construction Management Services portion for this project is estimated at \$2,567,458. The funding for this project will come from the Highway 65 Joint Powers Authority fees and County Traffic Impact Fees. Funding for the Construction Management Services for this project is included in the 2008/2009 Fiscal Year Budget.
