COMPOSITION: Composed of seven (7) members: One from each Supervisorial District with terms concurrent with the District Supervisor and appointed by the Board. 2 At-Large members appointed by the Board of Supervisors; (Ord. 4879-B, 01/20/98) shall be residents of the unincorporated area of the County, one At-Large member shall reside east of the Sierra Crest with a one year term commencing on 01/01/98 to 01/01/99, thereafter, the term will be for four years. One At-Large member shall reside west of the Sierra Crest with a term of three years, commencing 01/01/98 to 01/01/01, thereafter, the term will be for four years.
