Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution authorizing the County Clerk to render election services for the elections to be held November 4, 2008.

Background

Pursuant to federal and state law and the Placer County charter, certain federal, state, and county elections are to be conducted by this office on the first Tuesday in November each even-numbered year. Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 also provide that special district and school Governing Bodies may request the Board of Supervisors to order their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to said Bodies on a reimbursable basis. For the County Clerk to perform the requested functions pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code 5303, approval by resolution of the Board of Supervisors is required.

Please see attached 'Exhibit A' for a list of jurisdictions seeking election and requested ballot measures.

Fiscal Impact

No net impact on the General Fund. Requesting jurisdictions will pay for these special elections based on the approved fee schedule for election services. Expenditures and expected reimbursement revenues for the requested election services have been included within the department's FY 2008-09 budget.

LIST OF MEASURES SCHEDULED FOR ELECTION

Measure N – Center Unified School District

(Shared with Sacramento County. Sacramento is lead county)

To acquire, construct, and improve school facilities, including building new schools and classrooms to reduce student overcrowding, improving existing schools for greater energy efficiency and increased access to computers and technology, and qualify the District for approximately \$250,000,000 in State funds, shall the District issue up to \$500,000,000 in bonds at legal interest rates, with a citizens' oversight committee, annual audits, no money for administrator salaries, and provided funds cannot be transferred to the State?

Measure P – Placer Hills Fire Protection District
(Placer County only.)

Shall the Placer Hills Fire Protection District be allowed to exceed its Appropriations Limitation for four years beginning July 1, 2008 in order to maintain the current level of life and fire safety services protecting the residents and property of the fire district?

Measure Q – Colfax Elementary School District
(Placer County only.)

To provide comparable quality classrooms and technology as other nearby schools, update electrical systems to improve student access to computers/modern technology, construct a science/computer/vocational classroom laboratory to provide job skills, install solar panels to reduce utility costs, shall Colfax School District issue \$2,500,000 of bonds at legal rates, to acquire, construct, repair, equip schools, with no money for administrators' salaries, independent public audits, and spending annually reviewed by a citizens' oversight committee?

Measure R – Placer County
(Placer County only.)

Shall Article II, Section 207 of the Placer County Charter be amended to adjust the current \$30,000.00 maximum compensation for Placer County Supervisors, put in place by the voters of Placer County in 1992, to a maximum of \$48,000, effective January 1, 2009, with such amount adjusted each January 1 thereafter in accordance with a specially designated U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index?

Measure S – Placer County
(Placer County only.)

Shall Article V, Section 507 of the Placer County Charter be amended to change the terms of the County Counsel's employment from serving at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors to employment consistent with state general law, which provides for a four year term and removal during that term for neglect of duty, malfeasance or misconduct in office, or other good cause shown?

Measure T – Alta-Dutch Flat Union School District
(Placer County only.)

Shall the Alta-Dutch Flat Union School District, in order to protect our neighborhood school's academic excellence, reduce state budget cut impacts, limit class size increases, preserve academic programs, materials, and facilities, and maintain local control, collect \$45.00 per taxable parcel annually for four years beginning July 1, 2009, with citizen oversight and exemptions for taxpayers aged 65 and older?

Measure U – Tahoe Truckee Unified School District
(Shared with Nevada County. Placer is lead county.)

To improve energy efficiency, replace portable classrooms, upgrade computer/instructional technology, expand career/vocational classrooms, meet seismic safety/snow load requirements, shall Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District issue \$93,530,000 of bonds at legal rates to renovate, acquire, construct, repair, equip Truckee area schools, sites, facilities, with independent financial audits, citizens' oversight, no money for administrators' salaries and maintain 1999 voter approved tax rates?
